

Galle One-Day Tour Itinerary

Morning

1. Galle Fort

- Start your day exploring the iconic UNESCO World Heritage Site. Wander through the cobblestone streets and admire colonial-era buildings, boutiques, and cafes.
- Key sites within the fort:
 - **Galle Lighthouse:** A picturesque spot for photos.
 - **Dutch Reformed Church:** A historical church from the Dutch period.

 - Duration: 45 minutes.
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Evening

6. Koggala Lake (Optional)

- If time permits, take a boat ride on Koggala Lake, which is surrounded by lush greenery and dotted with small islands. Visit **Madol Duwa**, a famous island with literary significance in Sri Lanka.
- Duration: 1–1.5 hours.

7. Galle Fort Sunset

- Return to Galle Fort to watch the sunset from the fort walls, a magical way to end your day.
 - Duration: 30 minutes.
